Remember to say:

- why computers are useful to students;
 - what you use a computer for;
 - what disadvantages computers have

You are going to give a talk about music. You will have to start in 1.5 minutes and will speak for not more than 2 minutes.

Remember to say:

- why music is important in our life;
 - what genres of music you prefer and why;
 - whether you have a favourite singer\ band, why you like him/ her/it
-

You are going to give a talk about holidays. You will have to talk for 1.5–2 minutes.

Remember to say:

- what holidays your family celebrate
- what your favourite holiday is, why
- what you like more: giving presents or getting presents

You have to talk continuously

You are going to give a talk about the place where you live. You will have to start in 1.5 minutes and will speak for not more than 2 minutes.

Remember to say:

- what your town is famous for;
 - what your favourite place in your town is, and why you like it;
 - whether you are going to stay in your town after leaving school or move to another place, and why

You are going to give a talk about TV. You will have to talk for 1.5–2 minutes.

Remember to say:

- why TV is important in modern society
 - what your favourite TV programme is
 - what you prefer: watching TV or reading a book, why
-

You are going to give a talk about sports. You will have to start in 1.5 minutes and speak for not more than 2 minutes (10-12 sentences).

Remember to say:

- why a lot of young people do extreme sports nowadays
 - what sports clubs and teams there are in your school
 - what you do to keep fit
-

You are going to give a talk about your best friend. You will have to talk for 1.5–2 minutes.

Remember to say:

- what qualities attract you to him/her;
 - if there is anything you'd like to change in him/her;
 - what you do together
-

You are going to give a talk about Russia. You will have to talk for 1.5–2 minutes.

Remember to say:

- what geographical facts about Russia make it a special country;
 - what places in Russia you will advise to visit, why;
 - if you are proud to be a Russian resident, why
-

You are going to give a talk about natural phenomena. You will have to start in 1.5 and will speak for not more than 2 minutes.

Remember to say:

- what natural phenomena can happen around the world – in cold, hot regions, near the ocean, in the mountains;
 - what natural phenomena can take place in our region – the Urals;
 - if you have ever experienced any natural phenomenon
-

You are going to give a talk about travelling. You will have to start in 1.5 minutes and speak for not more than 2 minutes (10-12 sentences).

Remember to say:

- why modern people travel so much
 - what tourists usually do while travelling
 - what places in your region you recommend tourists should visit

You are going to give a talk about mass media. You will have to talk for 1.5–2 minutes.

Remember to say:

- what types of mass media you know
 - whether you read newspapers and/or magazines and why/why not
 - give your opinion about advertisements and commercials

Remember to say:

- what kind of shops you know
 - why modern shopping centres are popular
 - what you like to buy, why? how you spend your pocket money
